Information for Commonwealth Market Stallholders

Event overview

As a Platinum Jubilee Pageant Partner, Cadogan who own and manage 93 acres of Chelsea, will be arranging festivities throughout the weekend and bringing together the neighbourhood in celebration of the Platinum Jubilee

On Saturday 4 June, the King's Road will be pedestrianised (from Sloane Square to Cheltenham terrace) for a Street Party. The last time the road was closed for an event (at Christmas), it was incredibly popular, attracting over 162,000 people to the area that day.

The King's Road Street Party activities will include:

- Roaming performers
- Neighbourhood partners delivering a variety of complementary entertainment including children's treasure hunt and activities (corgi biscuit decorating, flag-making), flower-crown making, playwrighting, live music and more
- The Duke of York Square Saturday Fine food market on the green outside of Saatchi, which will be open for picnics
- Long trestle table/s dressed with flowers on the King's Road
- A Commonwealth Market on the King's Road
